

Dress for Success

Knowing how to dress professionally is an important life skill to have. - Young men should wear a collared shirt (polo or button-down) or a nice sweater, slacks and a belt. - Young women should wear a nice shirt or sweater with pants or a skirt, or a nice dress. Stay away from jeans and shorts, skirts or dresses that are too short, clothing that is too tight, spaghetti straps and casual sneakers or sandals (like flip flops).
- Dress for the situation. For example, a polo shirt and pants or a skirt may be fine for an
 interview at a restaurant, but a suit or nice dress would be more appropriate if
 interviewing for an internship with an elected official.

Finally, regardless of the situation, make sure you check everything off the list below to look and feel your best:

 Shower and wear deodorant.
 Go light on perfume or cologne, or don't wear any.
 Style hair neatly to keep it out of your face.
 Keep a mint handy to make sure breath is fresh.
 Keep accessories to a minimum.
 Put your cell phone on silent, and keep it out of sight.
